In the literal, bodily, physical return (second coming) of Jesus Christ

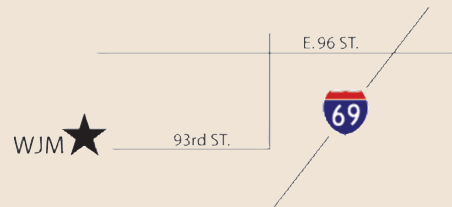
In the reality of Heaven as the eternal home of the redeemed and Hell as the eternal abode of the unsaved

DONATIONS

Donations may be brought to the warehouse during our hours of operation or be left in the blue donation bin located behind our building. Donated items are carefully sorted, cleaned and placed in our upstairs "showroom" to be taken by visiting missionaries.

THE SHOWROOM

Upstairs we have approximately 6000 sq ft of well-organized shelving and racks to display goods available to be taken. All items are in new or near new condition. These include homeschool, study & reading books, Bibles, office and school supplies, personal items, OTC medication, household goods, clothing, shoes, linens, craft materials, diapers, baby needs and equipment and much more.

Visits to the warehouse are by appointment only, This can be done through our online application, email correspondence or a phone call.
